With London in Tier 2, these events could be cancelled at short notice so it's best to check on the direct websites and book ahead where possible.

#### Miracle at Henrietta

At long last, a Christmas miracle has arrived, swooping in to save 2020's big day from being far from exciting.

The festively famous pop-up bar phenomenon, Miracle, is arriving in London for the third time, at Henrictta Hotel, meaning us Londoners too can enjoy the overtly festive and kitsch atmosphere. This year, however, because the festive season has been disrupted by lockdown and the pandemic, they've launched The Extended Christmas Story by Miraele, meaning you can get your festive thrills right through until 20th January.





The Christmas pop-up will be bringing its famous cocktails, including the Bad Santa and SanTaRex. Plus a few new creations, including the Fruiteake Flip, made up of brandy, Jamaican Overproof rum, amaretto, fruiteake, cherry bitters and whole egg, and the Jolly Koala, made with gin, vermouth and pine-cardamon-sage cordial.
